Provide critical animal husbandry care for shelter animals, including a variety of cleaning tasks. Aide in tasks that support a kennel environment that improves the quality of life for the animals in our care!

This is the opportunity for you if:

- You possess a strong desire to reduce animals' stress in the shelter environment.
- You're willing to get dirty for the animals! This role involves kennel cleaning and scooping poop.
- You are available mornings
- You're emotionally equipped for fast-paced service in crowded conditions.
- You recognize that you can make a difference through indirect care! There is no animal handling in this role.

What can you expect from your role as an Animal Care Team Volunteer?

Your service experience will involve:

- Kennel maintenance, including dog kennel cleaning.
- Other shelter husbandry critical to maintaining disease control and minimizing stress, including shelter laundry and dishes.
- Environmental enrichment, providing bedding and toys for the animals in our care.

Your benefits:

- You are a welcome addition to our shelter team and participate in the daily operations of the shelter. You acquire a well-rounded animal shelter perspective.
- You develop relationships with fellow staff and volunteers who share your interest in animal welfare.
